I earned my doctorate at The Pennsylvania State University. I authored an article published in Education Magazine Dec./Jan. 1980.

Some highlights of my teaching career include: appeared on the front cover of State College Magazine as one of the best teachers in Centre County, (web site www.statecollegemagazine.com, June 2005 Vol. XX, No. 6 page 36); nominee for best teacher in America by the Disney Corporation in 2002; appeared twice in Who's Who Among America's Teachers; earned The American Family Institute's Gift of Time Tribute.

In July 2009, I presented four lectures in conjunction with Professor Emeritus Arthur Goldschmidt (an internationally recognized expert on the Middle East) at The Pennsylvania State University on U.S. Foreign Policy.

I have been interviewed numerous times on local radio and television. The topics have been Abraham Lincoln, John Kennedy and the presidential elections of 2000, 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016. March 14th, and October 21st, 2008 on WPSU-TV, I was interviewed by Patty Satalia, on the American Presidency. I was interviewed, by Mr. Jerry Fisher, on November 4th, 2016 on 970AM, WBLF radio on the topic of the 2016 Presidential Election.

I have been invited four times to speak at The Pennsylvania Military Museum. On November 5th, 2016 I was asked to speak on the topic of President Gerald Ford, on Military Appreciation Day.

After an extensive interview process, I was notified on March 23rd, 2012 by Mrs. Dorine Nielsen, Manager of Entertainment Programs for the booking agency Sixth Star Entertainment that I am one of their Special Interest Program Lecturers. This means that I am now eligible to present my courses on the ships of the Princess Cruise and Royal Caribbean Cruise lines.

Starting in 2007, I have traveled throughout the Mid-Atlantic States teaching U.S. history topics at retirement communities. Some of the communities I have been privileged to teach many of my courses at, are:

My small business has now expanded beyond the Middle Atlantic States. An organization named Senior Scholars, invited me to teach at the Wildacres Resort in North Carolina. In April 2019, they asked me to teach the following courses, over a period of four days. The first course they chose was The United States Constitution And You. The second course they chose was World War I – The Forgotten War 1914-1918.

In 2019 the organization, named OWLS, (Older Wiser Lifelong Scholars) invited me to teach on October 10th and 11th at the Westminster Thurber Community in Columbus, Ohio. The course they chose was The U.S. Supreme Court.

Each year, for the past eight years I have taught two of my courses (one course in May and one course in September) at the Chautauqua Institute in New York. These programs are sponsored by the Road Scholar Organization.

At Chautauqua in May 2019, I presented my course The Top Three Presidential Scandals Since 1972. I returned to Chautauqua in September 2019 to teach my course entitled Presidents and Their Religion.
